The Jet Precision Aerobatic Championships, will be at the National Flying site at the AMA, September 1-2.

**The classes will be:**

- F3S Sport Jet - FAI Sequence
- F3S Scale Jet - FAI Sequence
- F3S EDF - shortened sequence
- FreeStyle

**Details:**

We will be on Site 3, at the AMA International Modeling Center (IAC),  
5161 E Memorial Dr., Muncie IN 47302

**Schedule:**

August 31st we have the site for practice.

There will be a mandatory pilots meeting at 8:15AM each contest day.

- For the F3S and EDF classes, we will get as many rounds as we can.
- Freestyle will be one round each day.

**Class Details:**

For the F3S Sport Jet, F3S Scale Jet, and EDF classes, we will follow the FAI's judging guide and all rules about flying the aircraft.

Regarding the aircraft themselves, there are no restrictions - gyro's are ok for example.

For the EDF class, the only restriction is that the jet has to take off and land on it's landing gear.

The sequence was intentionally shortened to allow a variety of EDF jets participate.

**Freestyle:**

The freestyle will be a normal format for aerobatic freestyle - The flight time must be 4 minutes, an absolute maximum of 5 minutes.

- There is no hard deck, if you touch the ground or anything attached to the ground, you zero the round.
- No high G maneuvers towards the flight line.
- You must fly in one of the F3S classes to fly Freestyle.
